PulseCheck ED allows EHI export for a single patient and for a patient population. The recommended data export format is CCDA 2.1.




## **Single Patient:**

For a single patient, a user with appropriate admin permissions may perform a manual EHI export as follows:

1. From the All Menu click Archive and search for patient



2. Choose a patient visit and select Chart Coding from All Menu



- 3. On Chart Coding Click Send CCD.
- 4. Repeat this process for all the patient's visits.

## **Patient Population:**

PCED also has the capability to export EHI for an entire patient population upon request. Multiple formats are supported including CCDA, csv, and machine-readable pdf. Please contact your PulseCheck representative.
